Vivek is teaching seminars on Sanskrit, Mantra and Tantra, performing rituals as a priest.

Vivek is a German-born German Indian, who lived most of the last years in a little ashram at Varanasi, on the banks of the river Ganges. His uncle, a saint of that holy city, initiated him into the spiritual science. He received his Yoga instruction very early from R. Sriram



(direct student of T.K.V. Desikachar, the son of T. KrIshnamacharya).

Having studied Sanskrit at the universities in the East and the West, his Sanskrit Guru is the world renowned Sanskritist Vāgiśa Śāstrī with whom he studies regularly since 1997.

Since 2004, Vivek has been concentrating on the Shaivism of Kashmir, studying from one of its world foremost authority, Dr. Mark Dyczkowski.
